Assigned to Tactical Division. This assignment was a "Specialized Patrol" assignment. Duties ranged from aggravated robbery stake-outs to burglary apprehension details to riot control. This assignment required Dignitary Protection duties to supplement the SWAT Team. This unit had the distinction of being "best of the best."

Jan. 1988 to Jan. 1990

Reassigned to Training Division as a Training Specialist. Duties were the training of pre-service and in-service personnel. In firearms instruction, self-defense, physical training and law. Credentials: Firearms instructor, Basic Texas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Education instructor.

Jan. 1990 Promoted to Sergeant

Assigned to Central Command Patrol Division

Assigned to Tactical Section as supervisor. From June 1990 to Sept. 1990 entire unit was re-assigned on IDY status to the Auto Theft Division.

Sept. 1990

Assigned as the first supervisor to lead full-time SWAT squad. Duties required the training of team members, procurement of equipment and management of the budget. This squad was eventually absorbed into the Gang Task Force to deal with rising gang issues.

Nov. 1992

Re-assigned to Central Division as a patrol sergeant.

April 1994.

Promoted to Lieutenant assigned to Central Division as shift commander.

Feb. 1996

Re-assigned to Mission Valley as patrol shift commander.

Assigned as Acting-Commander of Mission Valley Command.

Assigned as Interim Deputy Chief of Region 1. (Central and Pebble Hills commands).
